RE: SUMMER 2008 BASKETBALL SIGN-UP

There will be a meeting Monday, May 5th in the Central Valley Commons at 7:00 PM. The purpose of this meeting is to inform all players of available summer basketball events and to obtain summer registration fees for all tournaments, leagues, and team camps that you would like to participate in. We ask that you come prepared by bringing at least one parent and having a firm idea of what you plan to participate in. Since Summer Basketball activities are on a pay-to-play basis, we ask that you bring either a check or some form of payment to the meeting to cover registrations. Please see me about payment issues or concerns.

Costs are as follows: (All costs are per person/per event)

LADY BEARS CAMP	\$79 (Grades 9-12) \$43 (Grades 3-8)
TOURNAMENTS	\$25/each + (Travel & Lodging)
TEAM CAMPS	\$260 (GU)

After much discussion and consideration of the costs, I have concluded that the experience gained from participating in a summer basketball program justifies asking the expenditure on your part. I have been privileged to be a part of a summer basketball program for the past 11 years and have experienced nothing but positive comments and results from both players and parents of this procedure.

If you plan to participate in an out of town tournament, you will need to figure in a room and board cost of at least \$60-80/night, cheaper if split amongst several players. **You are responsible for your transportation to these events, and are responsible for all costs, which are endured.** You are more than welcome to stay with friends or family in the areas in which we play. If several players can ride and stay with each other at these tournament sites, your costs will not only be reduced, but also appreciated by many.

I know many of you will have questions pertaining to the costs of these events, how teams will be decided, and monetary expectations from the parents, and I will be more than happy to address any questions you may have on the night of the meeting. If you are concerned about the direction of the summer program and what I personally expect, please feel free to call me. The best way to get all the information will be to be in attendance the night of the meeting, for it is there that I will discuss the events available and field questions many may have at one time instead of possibly the same question many times.
